

## FRIENDS OF CHARTERHOUSE GOLF CLUB 9 HOLE COURSE

### ON COURSE RISK HIGHLIGHTER

ALL MEMBERS SHOULD READ THE COMPREHENSIVE  
VERSION OF THE CLUB RISK ASSESSMENT

1. Be aware of the behaviour of other golfers and their place on the course. Do not play a shot until you are sure there is little risk of your ball hitting any other person particularly if you are hitting towards an area hidden from your view. Always shout "FORE" if you hit a wayward shot.
2. If lightning is expected or begins during play you must not continue and must take shelter in a safe place. The starting shed and the Charterhouse Club are two safe locations. Discontinuing Play- Rule 5-7 as stated in the Royal & Ancient Rules of Golf sets out the repercussions of restarting after a stoppage for lightning.
3. In foggy conditions do not attempt to play if you cannot see where the ball will land.
4. In wet conditions many slopes are very slippery. It is essential that footwear designed for golf is worn at all times. In addition slopes considered to be particularly risky and to be avoided are e.g. behind the 3rd green/ to the left and behind the green at the 4th hole/ in the quarry at holes 4 and 5
5. Many bunkers have sloping sides. The risk of slipping on these slopes is medium high. Always enter and leave from the lowest point and never take trolleys on to these slopes.
6. Many tees and greens have sloping sides. To avoid risk of slipping and skidding do not take trolleys on to slopes surrounding tees.
7. Deviation from indicated directions will be at the entire risk and responsibility of the individual.
8. Any accidents occurring on the course are to be reported immediately to the Charterhouse Club Reception or call security on 07831 467362.

### LOCAL RULES

#### 1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18-2)

- a) Beyond the fence or posts on the left hand side of the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th holes, or beyond the posts on the right of the 2nd.
- b) Within or beyond the hedge of the 5th 7th and 9th greens.
- c) Beyond the posts or trees bordering both the 1st and 9th holes.

#### 2. STONES IN BUNKERS (Rule 15-2)

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.

#### 3. STAKED TREES (Rule 16-1)

If a staked tree interferes with a players stance or the area of swing, the ball must be lifted and dropped one club length to the nearest point of relief.

#### 4. SPRINKLERS (Rule 6 -1)

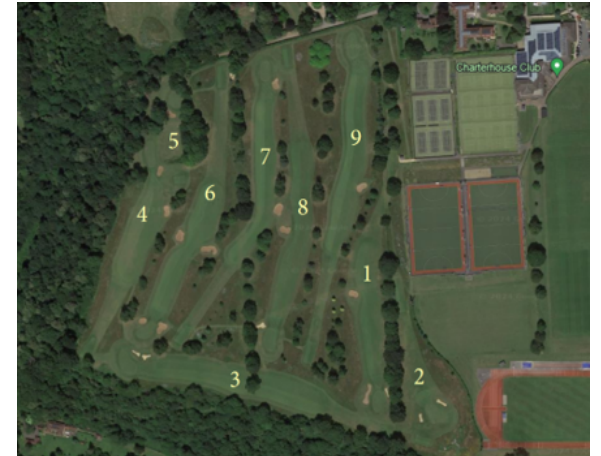
All pop up sprinklers and other irrigation heads and hoses are immovable obstructions and relief from interference may be obtained within one club length of the nearest point of relief.

#### Penalty for breach of a local rule:

Match Play - loss of a hole  
Stroke Play - two strokes
